Spring 2018 Newsletter!

You are in receipt of this newsletter due to your support and interest of Edric's artwork as a wood artist and sawdust maker. We are a bit relieved to say that Edric is finally getting back into his saw dust pile and life is starting to move in the right direction for his fans, friends and collectors of his work and most importantly for me. For the interested, Edric has been battling Hernia problems for years and has had numerous corrective surgeries performed over the last 2 years, nothing life threatening, but it has sapped his strength and his artistic energies. Publishing this bit of news related to his health will give many of you a little insight into the failed Spring Open Studio as well as not completing commissions in a timely manner.

As previously stated it has taken Edric a bit longer than we first projected to fully start working in his shop



space and we are finally able to release this newsletter as an update for Edric and his intended plans for the next few months. While he is busy trying to get ready to release 2 new pieces for an upcoming summer exhibit he is also planning on holding an Open Studio in the Fall around mid-October and this is in lieu of the missed opportunities this past spring.

We often hear and read about fans loving his artwork but simply can't afford his creations, I fully understand and I can sympathize with you. And, for those who are local we strongly suggest that a

private viewing of his work is your best way to see and understand the nuances of this artform, perhaps you may even see what's *in-the-works (looking at and appreciating his work is still free)*. But please do so through an appointment. For first time visitors Edric's studio has a separate entrance and we welcome those who are interested in browsing or looking for a special gift.

We have been tasked with an unusual request, Edric's biggest collector after me, has asked that we assist him in reselling one of Edric's earliest award winners. The photo (at left) is a piece titled "Wood Don't Fly" created



in the Spring of 95, and Yes, you read it correctly, that Summer it won the Best of Show Award at Craftsmen's Guild of Pittsburgh Members Exhibit. Created from a Siberian Elm Burl, this hollow vessel features a large burled top and a natural cavity on it's side, as well as very impressive grain patterns. It is one his tallest hollow vessels standing 14 in. tall x 10 in. dia. originally finished with Tung Oil. It has been on display and enjoyed by the Shefler family in their homes in St Michaels, MD and Gibsonia, PA for over 23 years, nevertheless due to relocations and downsizing this piece is offered as an opportunity to own one of Edric's earlier pieces. If interested additional photos are available. Serious offers will be evaluated by Edric and Peter.

This type of request is something that we would not normally handle but since the Shefler collection contains well over 30 of Edric's pieces. Edric and I feel that this could be an excellent chance to own one of his earlier creations.
